TEST APPLICATION

Skin reactions to Reductase 5 are uncommon. However, to assure that your skin tolerates it well:

On the first day apply the product to a small area of your face or neck.

If the area develops marked redness, itching or irritation, you may be sensitive to an ingredient in Reductase 5 and should discontinue use of the product.

If mild irritation develops, you are encouraged to repeat the test application prior to general use, to assure that irritation does not worsen.

If no adverse response is noted the day following application of the test dose, proceed to use as follows.

DAILY USE

Morning and evening, cleanse the face with a cleanser of your choice.

Dry the skin.

Apply thin layer of cream to the face, covering the cheeks, chin and upper lip.

If facial hair is an issue on the forehead, apply there as well.

Gently massage until the product is absorbed fully.

HOW LONG?

While many users report improvement within a week or two, keep in mind that restoring balance in the hair follicle can take time. It may take as much as 60-90 days to see the long-term results from Reductase 5.
